Arriving at School

In the mornings, the drop of time for children is from 8:30am to 8:50am. The school gates are opened and manned by a member of staff at 8.30am and not before. Children MUST NOT be dropped off before this time as they are not supervised. Tractors and vehicles go up and down the lane and we are very concerned about the safety of pupils left on their own before we open up the gate. Several parents have brought their concerns to our attention. Children who need to arrive at school before 8.30am should be booked into our Breakfast Club. They should not be left alone at the gate.

Can we please also ask that registration and lessons start at 8:50am, so children MUST be in school for this time. We have several children arriving later than this quite regularly and this is very disruptive to the other children and teacher.
