

Holywell Church of England School playground relational behaviour management approach.

Child breaks a golden rule.

Does the behaviour change?

Yes

Adult gives child a verbal request to change the behaviour.




Praise the child and return to the start of the flow chart.

No

Adult gives a warning that if behaviour continues, a 5 minute time out will be given.

Does the behaviour change?

Yes



Praise the child and monitor behaviour. If it returns, proceed to 5 minute time out. Otherwise, return to the start of the flow chart.

No

Give a 5 minute time out

No

Does the behaviour persist or escalate/ become physical?

Yes

Adult to ask child to sit out. Ensure the child is calm and talk through the situation. Inform Mrs Lowrey and follow consequences.

Consequences

Physical behaviour with no mark or injury - off the playground for that day.

Physical behaviour that causes a mark or a second incident of physical behaviour - off the playground for the remainder of the day and following day.

Any physical behaviour will result in direct movement to consequences.

Any physical behaviour resulting in marks will be reported to parents and recorded.

School reserves the right to remove children from trips or events should physical behaviours continue and will discuss use of suspensions for individual cases.

All staff will spend time talking to each child following a consequence being put in place. We will spend time looking at helping the child find a way to manage the situations in a positive way.
